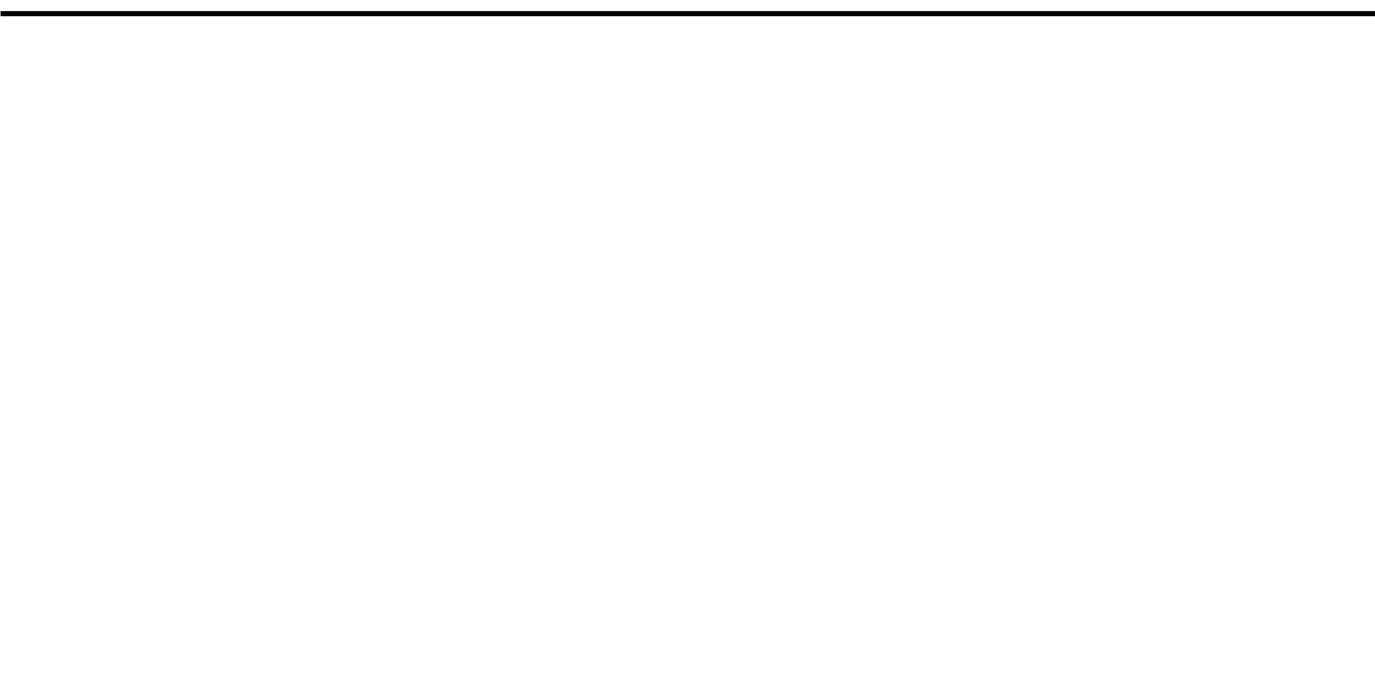


350 km streets, roads concreted: Kabul Municipality

Since over four months of Kabul municipality taking over new leadership, achievements have been unprecedented in the last 16 years. According to their achievements, the Kabul Municipality (KM) spokesman Jull Sultan, since the contract, the new leadership offered a clear treatment of work based on which implementation of projects in different parts of the city has been prioritized. In the first stage, the new leadership issued all available problems in the capital city and stop work respectively. These steps include: 20 stages and applications has in refer to ward authorities, which infrastructure projects to be carried out in the next few months which is unprecedented achievement in the last 16 years.

Tracking the construction of 48 km roads that were undertaken in 1994 (2017), Jull Sultan said, although these roads were expected to be built in the past years, but these goals were not achieved due to negligence and abandonment of them out of funds. The road from Ghid Farwan circle to Sarabzy circle, the road from Sarabzy circle to Lal-e-Ghar circle, the road from Lal-e-Ghar circle to Pasbad Fandi circle and the road from Golgape Park circle to Khoshab-Habibullah circle are among projects which are underway by Kabul Municipality. The construction of four other main roads including the road from Tahmany circle through police station to Quba-Naghab circle and the road from Quba-Naghab Khwa to Aramjooq area are at the procurement stage.

Some areas including the road to Tashir-Barchi area in Lal-e-Ghar circle, which according to MSF report has accumulated a population of over one and half million people has also been included. If Barchi road is connected in company road heavy traffic jam will be removed in this area. Sultan went on to say that Kabul Municipality has undertaken an independent and detailed plan for Barchi area. Preliminary preliminary steps of

Indian company will provide citizen services in Afghanistan

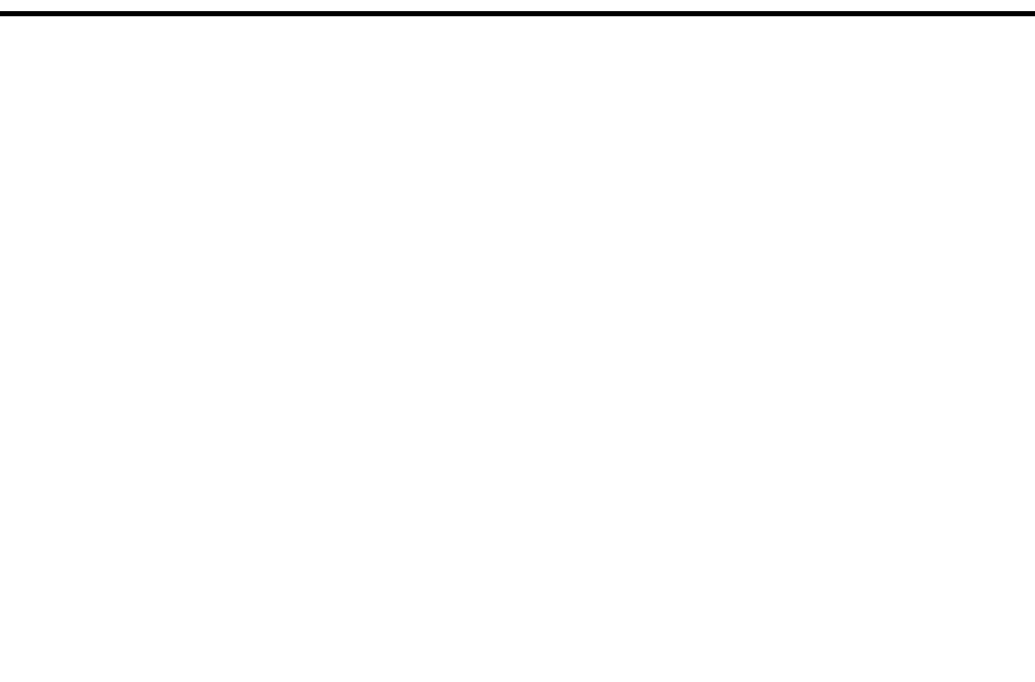
An Indian company has signed a preliminary contract for providing citizen services in Afghanistan. The company - BLS International - has entered into a contract with the Embassy of Afghanistan in the United Arab Emirates (UAE) for providing citizen services through registration of Afghan citizens. Under the agreement, the company will open application centers in UAE, Kuwait, Oman, Bahrain, Qatar and Saudi Arabia for the Embassy of Afghanistan. Registered citizens can exercise a wide range of rights such as passport, visa, free of movement and obtaining citizenship services.
