

Palestinian baby among 61 killed in Gaza border protests

A Palestinian baby died from gas inhalation at the Gaza border protests, the Gaza Health Ministry said on Tuesday. The Palestinian death toll in the border protests has now risen to 61, most killed by Israeli army fire. The ministry says six of those killed by gunshots were minors.

It was the deadliest day in Gaza since 2014 war between Israel and Gaza's ruling Hamas.
