Yemeni army conducts new drone strike against King Khalid airbase in Saudi Arabia

Spektrum for the Yemeni Armed Forces Brigadier General Yahya Saeed announced in a post published on the Twitter page that a domestically manufactured Qasbi-2K (Qasbi-2K) combat drone hit designated target near King Khalid airbase near the Saudi city of Khamsa Monday early Sunday.

The attack, he said, was a response to Riyadh's ongoing military aggression and brutal siege against Yemen.

The development came only a day after Yemeni armed forces and their allies struck the same airbase using two Qasbi-2K unmanned aerial vehicles.

On Saturday, the media bureau of Yemen's popular front-led movement released video footage of a rocket large with ground on in Saudi Arabia's southwestern border region of Jazan, where the troops made rapid advances and took control of dozens of Saudi military positions.

A Yemeni military official, speaking on condition of anonymity, told Arabic-language Al-Masrah television network that the multi-pronged offensive succeeded on the road linking al-Khabe to Wadi Jaz. Saudi army positions in al-Falaha (Hajjah) and al-Bayda (Hill) were targeted as well.

Yemeni forces managed to completely take control of several dozen villages in Saudi territory and attacked heavy concentrations of Saudi forces, he added.

The official went on to say that a number of Saudi officers and soldiers were killed and wounded in a series of ambushes that targeted their armored vehicles.

He noted that dozens of Saudi troops and their mercenaries, including Sudanese militiamen, were also captured, while some of them fled.

The Yemeni military official also said large quantities of various weapons and military equipment, which Saudi forces had abandoned in their positions, were seized by Yemeni troops.

"During the operation, 28 armored vehicles belonging to the Saudi army were destroyed and set on fire as well," he said.

Yemeni army soldiers and their allies have also done a Saudi in coordination three over the country's northern province of al-Jazir.



Saudi fighter jets launched six strikes against the Majlad district and another on the Majlad district in Yemen's strategic central province of Makhrah, but there were no immediate reports about possible casualties and the extent of damage.

Saudi warplanes also pounded the Khafra area, which is the site in the northern Yemeni province of al-Jazir, with no reports of casualties and damage quickly spreading.

Authorities in Vietnam have detected a new hybrid of two COVID-19 variants found in India and the United Kingdom, an official said.

Seymour Duan Long, deputy Vietnam health minister, told a government meeting on Saturday that scientists found the new variant after examining the genetic makeup of the virus that had infected some recent patients.

"That the new one is an Indian variant with mutations that originally belong to the UK variant is very important," he said.

Long said that the new variant might spread more easily than other variants of the virus, the minister said, adding that Vietnam would soon publish genetic data of the newly identified variant.

After successfully containing the virus for most of last year, Vietnam is grappling with rise in infections since the April that accounts for more than half of the total 148 reported cases. So far, there have been 47 deaths.

The Southeast Asian country had previously detected seven virus variants: B.1.221, B.1.449, B.1.152, B.1.153, B.1.154, B.1.155, and B.1.156.

Russia confirms \$500m loan for Belarus as West toughens sanctions

Moscow stepped up its support for Belarusian President Alexander Lukashenko amid outrage in the West about the granting of a European passport prize and the arrest of a dissident journalist.

The financial support was announced after Russian President Vladimir Putin held a second day of talks with Lukashenko, and issued the grant to a week tour in the Black Sea resort of Sochi on Saturday.

The money is part of a \$1.5bn loan that Russia promised Belarus as part of Moscow's efforts to stabilize its neighbor after mass protests broke out against Lukashenko's nearly three-decade rule last year.

Moscow received a first installment of \$500m on Saturday and will receive the second tranche before the end of June, the RIA Novosti news agency reported.

Putin also pledged to provide Belarus with a \$1.5bn loan to help it cope with the economic crisis caused by the EU's trade sanctions, according to Kremlin spokesman Dmitry Peskov.

Belarus has threatened to force a Russian jet to land in Minsk, Belarusian authorities sent a fighter jet to Belarusian President Alexander Lukashenko amid outrage in the West about the granting of a European passport prize and the arrest of a dissident journalist.

Both are in jail accused of orchestrating mass riots. Peskov said Lukashenko could be jailed for up to 15 years.

Several European nations have opposed flight bans on Belarusian airlines, while the US said that "full backing sanctions" on state-owned Belarusian companies will come into effect on June 3. Washington also said it was working with the EU to increase pressure on Lukashenko's government.

Putin has criticized the West's response, arguing with Lukashenko on Friday that the reaction was "not indifferent but hot."
