COVID-19: Ministry reports 78 deaths, 670 recoveries

KABUL — The Ministry of Public Health on Monday reported 147 new positive cases of COVID-19 out of 4,629 tests conducted in the last 24 hours.



hours. The ministry also reported 78 deaths and 670 recoveries from COVID-19 in the same period. Afghanistan has so far recorded 105,749 positive cases and 4,293 deaths from COVID-19.

According to Johns Hopkins University, the number of deaths from COVID-19 globally is more than 3,066,287 and the number of known global coronavirus cases is 178,895,037.
