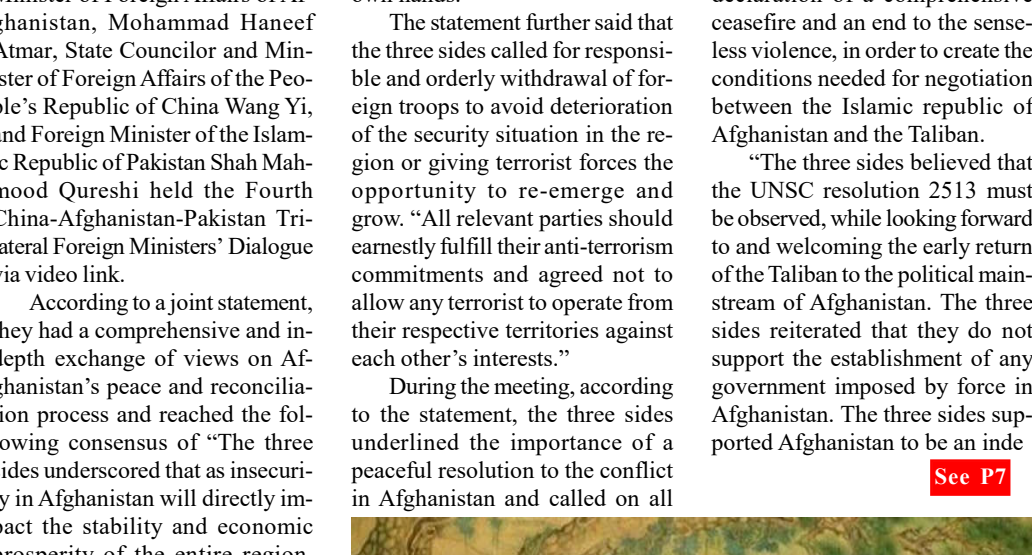
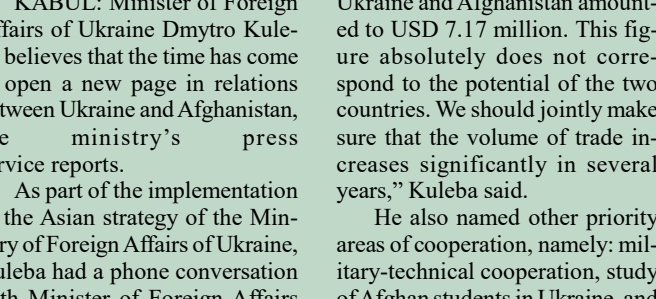


Trilateral meeting vows to work for peace in Afghanistan



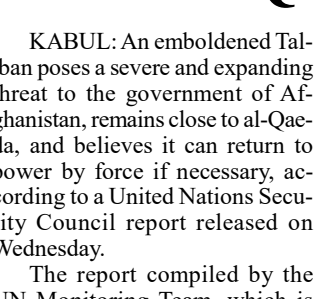

Security incidents have risen over 60% in the first three months of 2012 compared to the same period in 2011. The UN team says that the increase in "reported" incidents is not necessarily an indication of targeted assassinations that have become a feature of the violence in Afghanistan and that appear to be undertaken with the objective of weakening the capacity of government and intimidating civil society. The report also indicates that part of the Taliban leadership has no interest in the peace process, saying that "both deputy

The report assesses that, despite twenty years of warfare, "Taliban numbers remain 'robust' and 'recruitment has remained steady' — with estimates of the insurgent group's fighting strength ranging from 58,000 to 100,000," CNN reported.
