Israel attacks Hamas sites in Gaza in response to fire balloons

Israeli aircraft bombed Hamas sites in the Gaza Strip on Saturday in response to incendiary balloons launched from the Palestinian enclave, Israeli military said. There were no immediate reports of casualties or damage from the attack, but targeted that the Israeli military said was a rocket launching site and a compound belonging to Hamas, the political group that governs Gaza. Hamas had no immediate comment.

UN taps veteran Swedish diplomat to be new Yemen envoy

The UN announced the appointment of a Swedish diplomat to be the new UN envoy for Yemen on Friday. The diplomat will take over from Martin Griffiths, who will become the next under-secretary general for Humanitarian Affairs and Emergency Relief Coordinator (OCHA).



UN Secretary-General Antonio Guterres thanked Griffiths for his work and dedication to diplomatic efforts in Yemen over the years.

Griffiths is a veteran diplomat with a focus in the Middle East. He was previously the chief of the UN Division for the Middle East, and he has also served as the UN's representative to the Swedish Ministry of Foreign Affairs. US charges two Myanmar citizens over plot to attack UN ambassador

US prosecutors say they have charged two Myanmar citizens over a plot to attack the country's United Nations ambassador, Kwon Myeong-Tae, an outspoken supporter of the democracy movement who has faced criticism by the military government to gain.

In an alleged conspiracy filed by US investigators, the pair spoke of hiring assassins to force Kwon Myeong-Tae to resign or, if that failed, to kill him, officials said on Friday.

The plot, planned to seriously injure or kill Myanmar's ambassador to the United Nations in a planned attack on a foreign official, was to take place on Americans' soil," said Andrew Shinn, the US attorney for the southern district of New York.

Rosalee Maguire, the acting assistant director of the US Federal Bureau of Investigation, said law enforcement acted "quickly and diligently" after learning last month of the plot. The indictment was filed in the Southern District of New York.

The plot, which was planned to take place in the United States, was allegedly carried out by two Myanmar citizens, who were charged with conspiracy to commit murder and conspiracy to obstruct justice.

The Tunisian judiciary has opened an investigation against the Islamist Ennahda movement, after the disclosure of a lobbying contract with a private group which the movement could hold for weeks in its file.
